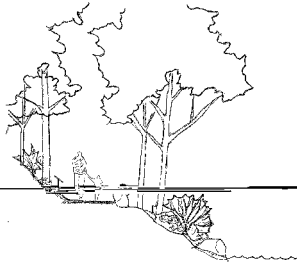
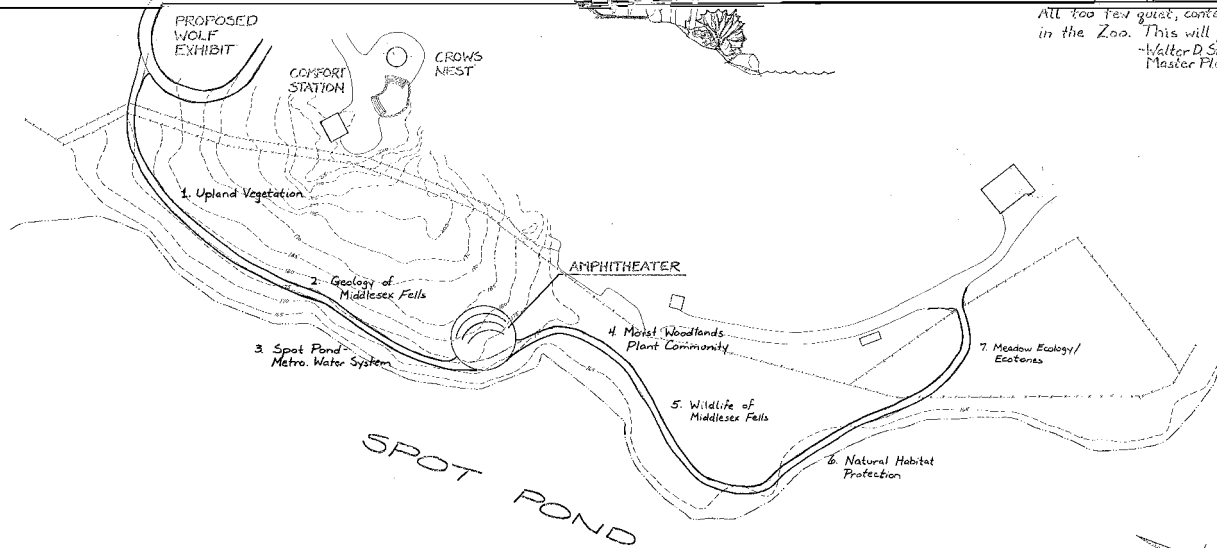


LOCUS
