MOTION TO EXTEND TIME FOR ALLEGING AND FILING
EXCEPTIONS

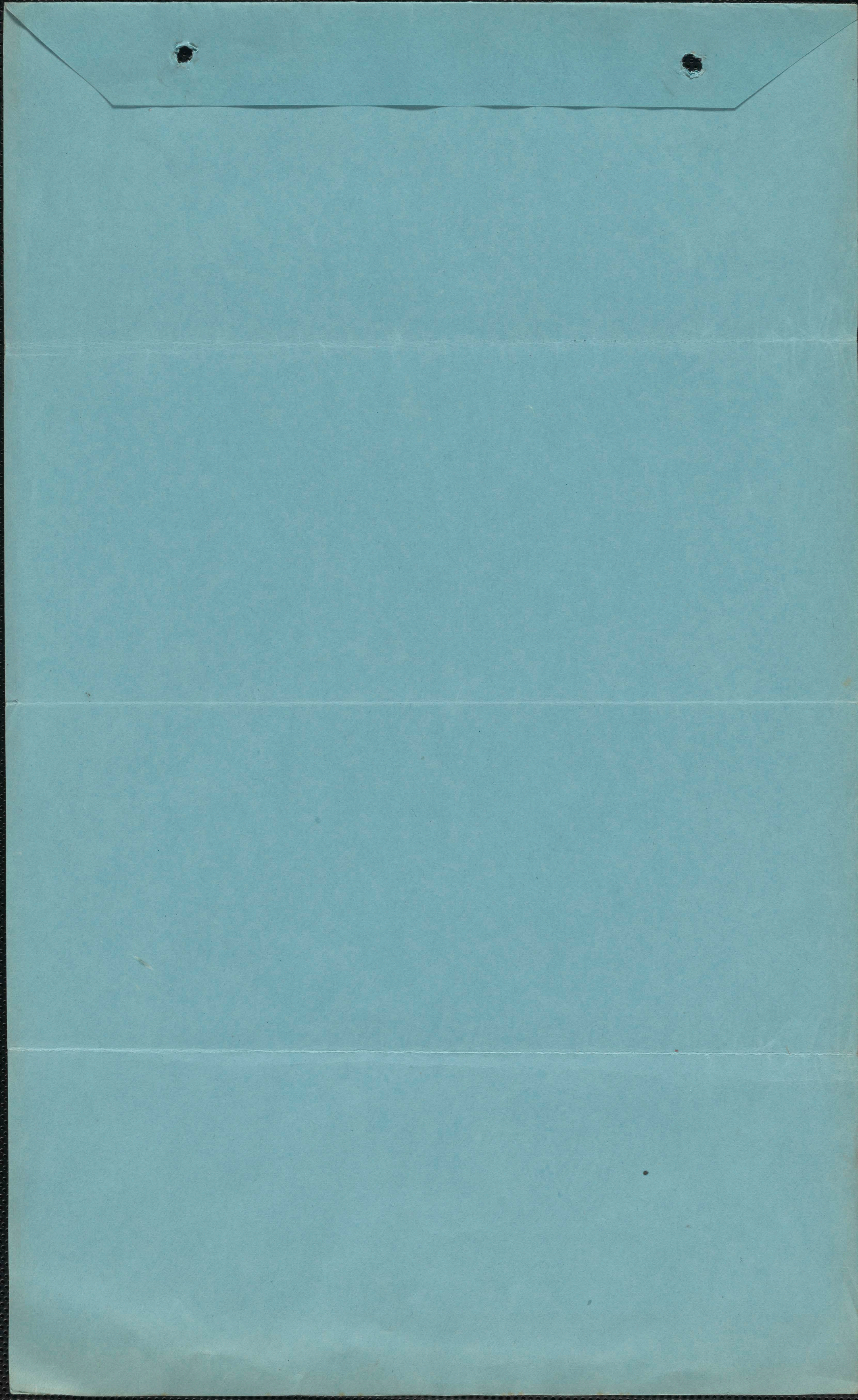
Now come the defendants Nicola Sacco and Bartolomeo Vanzetti, each for himself separately, and also jointly, and say that the time within which they and each of them, may allege exceptions and reduce the same to writing and file the same with the Clerk with respect to the action of Webster Thayer, J., then presiding, taken on October 1, 1924, upon their several motions for new trial, as heretofore three times extended, expires on Friday next, November 7, 1924; that they by their counsel have made substantial progress upon their Bills of Exceptions, but that by reason of the very substantial amount of stenographic copying involved therein, and by reason of the fact that their main Bill of Exceptions to which reference is made in their Bills now in preparation, is partially in the hands of the printer, and for that reason is not available to their counsel in toto, they will be unable to prepare and file their said Bill of Exceptions within the time fixed by the Court.

WHEREFORE said defendants, each for himself, and jointly, pray that the time within which they and each of them may allege exceptions to the action of the Court upon their respective Motions for new trial, and may reduce the same to writing and file the same with the Clerk, and give notice thereof to the Commonwealth, may be further extended from November 7, 1924, to and including November 21st 1924.
