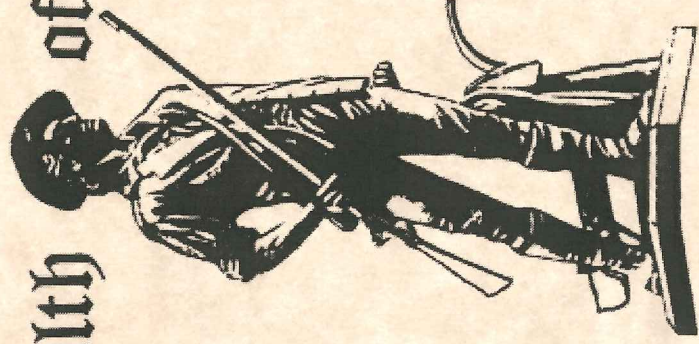


# Commonwealth of Massachusetts

His Excellency Governor Deval L. Patrick

- Whereas** As the holidays near and families make plans to come together, it is fitting to celebrate those families that have been formed through the adoption of infants, toddlers, siblings, school-aged children, children with disabilities and children of diverse ethnic and racial backgrounds; and
- Whereas** It is appropriate for all Massachusetts citizens to recognize the large number of children waiting to be adopted, and the outstanding commitment and service provided by dedicated adoptive parents,

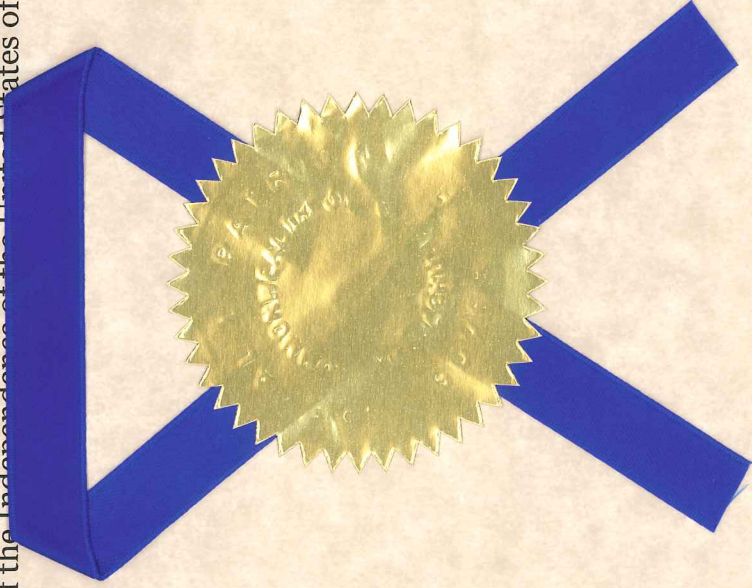
