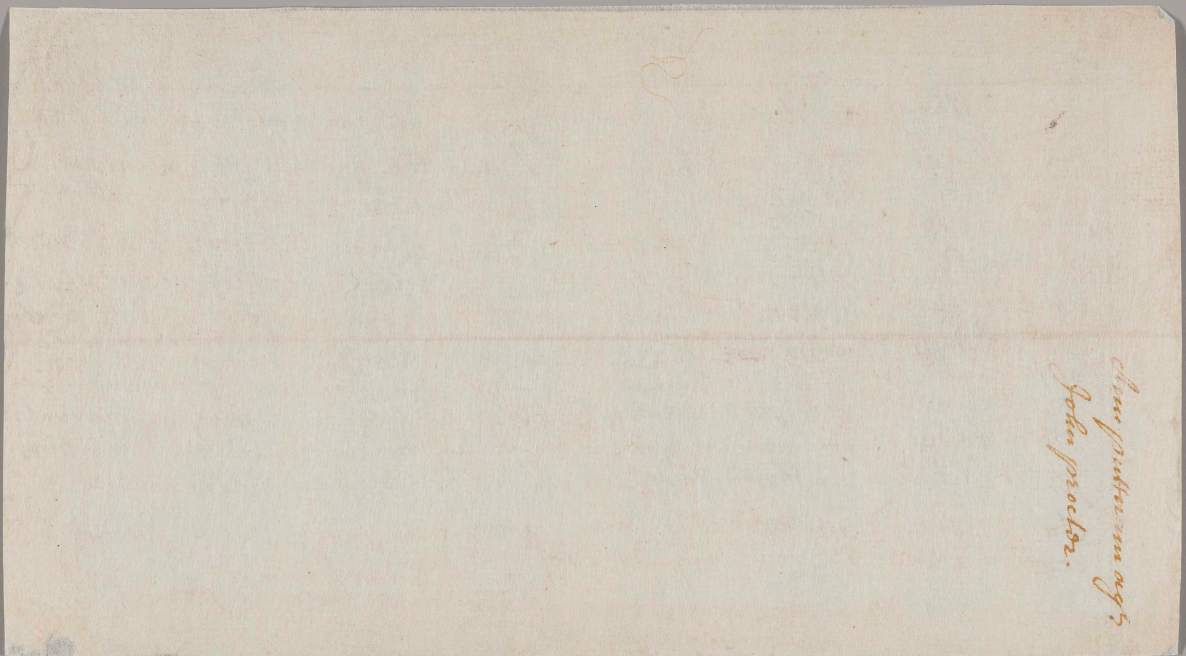


The Deposition of Ann Putnam ^{junr} who testified and said I have often
