an Indian Woman all of Salem Village
being this day brought before us upon
Suspicion of Witchescraft to say therein and
Every one of them committed. Tituba an
Indian Woman acknowledging & confessing
of fact. and Sarah Osburne and Sarah
Good denying of same before us there
appearing in all their examinations
sufficient Ground to believe them all.
in order to further Examination
they were all committed to the
Gaol in the County of Essex.

Tituba again examined and also Tituba as will appear
in their examinations given in

Sarah Good the wife of Wm Good of Salem
Village Labourer brought before us by
George Loeber Constable in Salem. to answer
for Joseph Dutchesson Thomas Putnam Jr of
Salem Village Goodman Complainant of
Witchescraft of these Majesties against Sarah
Good for suspicion of Witchescraft by her
Commitment and thereby much Injury done
to the Body of Elizabeth parrot. Magistrate
William Shina Putnam & Elizabeth Putnam
all of Salem Village as aforesaid according to
their Complaints as Warrant said Salem
March 29th 1692

Sarah Good upon Examination denied of
matter of fact (viz) of the ever did any
Witchescraft or hurt of abominable Children
or any of them.
The above named Children being all present
positively accused her of hurling of them
Sunday being within this two months and
also of murthering

Sarah Good denied of she had been at
their houses in Osburne or near them, or
had done them any hurt

all the accused children were positively
accused her face to face, upon which
they were all dreadfully tortured & tormented
for a short space of time, and of affliction and
torment being over they charged to Sarah Good
again. of she had then soe tortured them, and
came to them and did it. altho she was
personally then kept at a considerable distance
from them

Sarah Good being asked if she did not then
hurt them who did it, And the children
being againes tortured, she looked upon
them, And said if it was one of them who
brought into of house with us, who
asked her who it was, she then answered
and said it was Sarah Osburne, and Sarah
Osburne was then under custody of us in the
house; - And the children being quickly after
recovered out of there first said it was Sarah
Good and also Sarah Osburne of then did hurt
& torment, or afflict them altho with of
them at a some time at distance or Remote
from them personally; - Then words also saying
other Quotations put to her & children given
thereunto by us. according as is also given
in

Sarah Osburne the wife of John and Sarah Osburne
of Salem Village. brought before by Joseph
Herrick Constable in Salem; to Mr. Joseph
Hutchinson & Thomas Putnam the yeomen in
Salem Village Complainants on behalf of
thems Major, against Sarah Osburne, for
Suspicion of Witchcraft by her Committee, and
thereby much Injury done to the bodies of
Elizabeth parry Abigail Williams China
Putnam and Elizabeth Hubbard all of Salem
Village aforesaid, according to their Complain-

1692

Sarah Osburne upon Examination
denied y^e matter of fact (viz) of the error
in deerswood or that any Witchcraft or that
any Witchcraft, or that any of y^e aforesaid
children

The children aforesaid being all
personally present, accused her face to face
which being done, they were all hurt afflic-
and tortured very much; which being done
and they out of those that they said y^e said
Sarah Osburne did them thus and thus
them, Sarah Osburne being then & kept at
a distance personally from them. Sarah Osburne
was asked why she then hurt them. She
denied it. & in coming closer to her than
she could see much & hurt them and yet
she was at that distance personally from y^e
the answer she did not then hurt them nor
never did. she was asked who then did it
or who she employed to do it; she answered
she did not know of it since goes about in
her like one to do any hurt. Sarah Osburne
being told that Sarah Good one of her company
had upon Examination accused her. she with-
stood and denied it, according to
her Examination. which is more at large
given in as they will appear.
