1st day of **Nov.** in the year one thousand
nine hundred and **twenty four** at **Wrentham** in the County of Norfolk,
did assault and beat **James E. Carpenter** with intent to murder him by
shooting him and by such shooting did murder the said **James E. Carpenter**

against the peace of the said Commonwealth, and the form of the statute in such cases made and
provided.

Which complaint being read to and heard by the said **James Weeks** he is asked by the Court whether he is guilty or not guilty of the offence charged against **him** in the said complaint, who pleads and says that he is not guilty, when the case was adjourned to the **18th** day of **Nov.** A. D. 19**24**, at **nine** o'clock A. M., and the Defendant ordered to ~~recognize to the~~ **held** ~~Commonwealth with sureties in the sum of~~ **without bail** ~~hundred dollars for~~ ~~appearance to answer to said complaint as aforesaid, and did~~ ~~recognize.~~ On the **18th** day of **Nov.**, A. D. 19**24**, the case was further adjourned to **the 26th day of Nov. 1924**

when after due and full examination it is considered by the Court that there is probable cause to believe that the said Defendant is guilty of the offence charged in said complaint.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED AND ORDERED BY THE COURT, that the said Defendant ~~be committed without bail~~ ~~recognize with sureties to the Commonwealth in the sum of~~ ~~hundred dollars~~ for **his** personal appearance at the Superior Court next to be holden at Dedham, within and for said County of Norfolk, on the first Monday of **Dec.** next, to answer to said complaint, and to whatever else shall then and there be objected against **him** in behalf of the said Commonwealth, and abide the sentence or order of the Court thereon, and also in like manner personally to appear at any subsequent term of said Court, to which the proceedings in the premises may be continued, if not previously ~~surrendered and~~ discharged, and so from term to term, until the final decree, sentence or order of said Court thereon, and to abide such final decree, sentence or order of said Court, and not depart without leave, and stand committed ~~and~~ ~~without bail~~ ~~recognize,~~ and thereupon the said **James Weeks** as principal, before said Court ~~with~~ ~~as surety~~ ~~recognized according to the said order, refusing to comply with the said order to~~ ~~recognize,~~ was committed to the Common Jail in said County.
