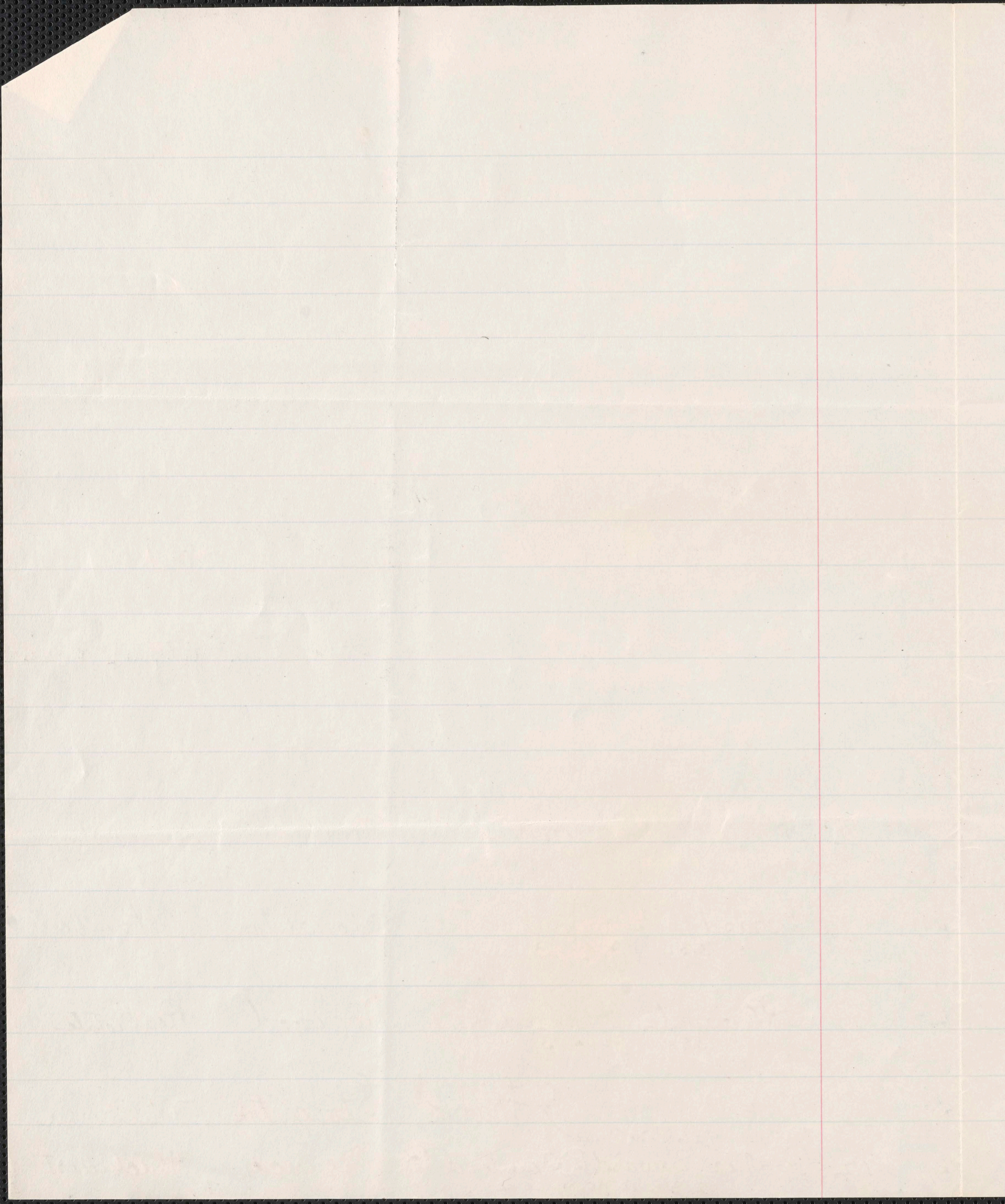

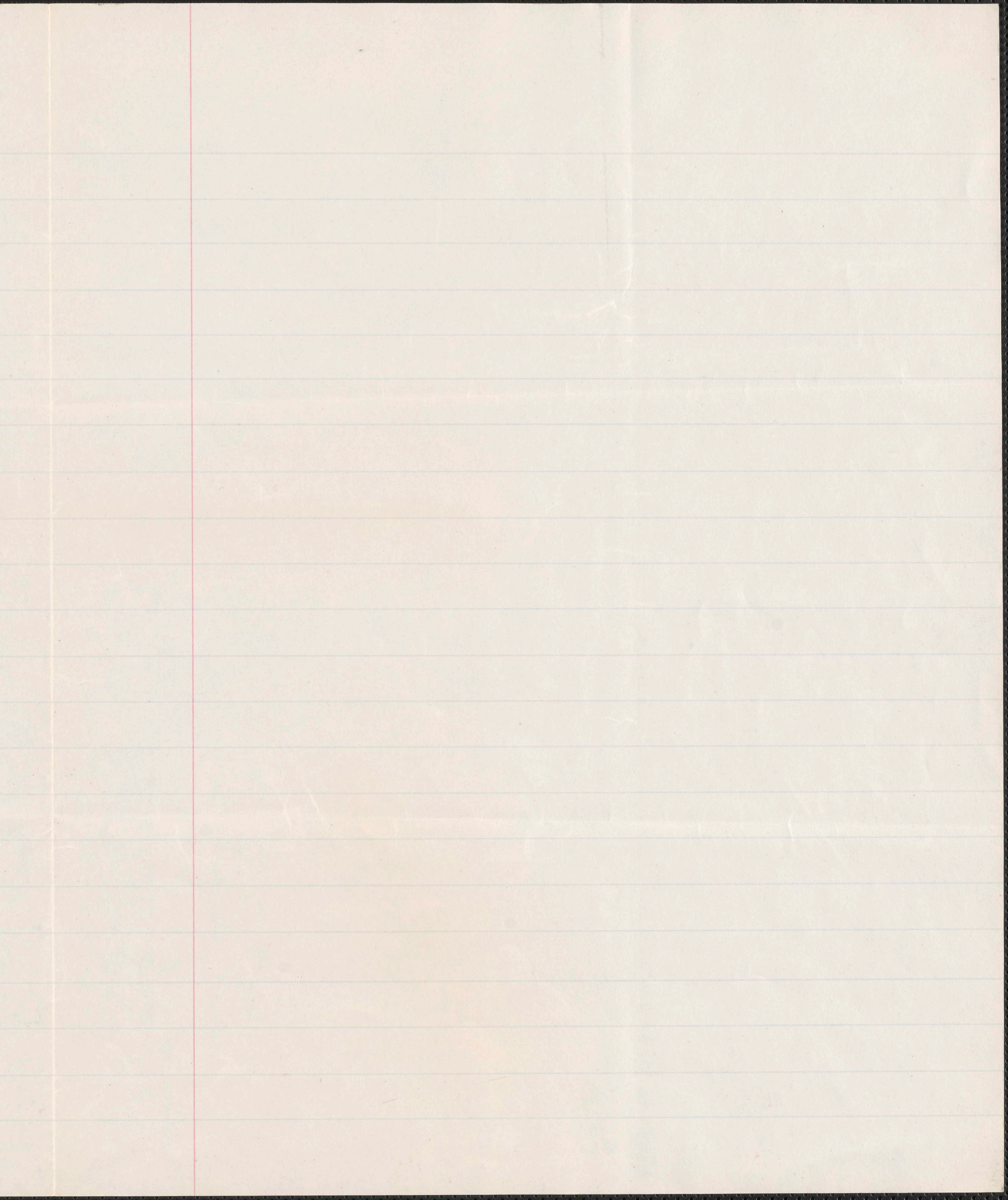

On the motion for a new trial the defendant asked the Judge to rule as matter of law "That where witnesses of equal candor, fairness and intelligence testify with equal opportunity of knowledge and memory, and their testimony is in all respects of equal weight and credibility and there is a conflict as to facts which cannot be reconciled, the number of witnesses then constitutes a preponderance and the verdict should be in harmony with the greater number of witnesses."

The judge refused to make this ruling, stating that it was not for the court to pass upon the questions of equal candor, fairness and intelligence, equal opportunity of knowledge and equal weight and credibility. The judge expressed the opinion that there was evidence which, if believed, justified the jury in finding for the plaintiff, and as a matter of discretion denied the motion for a new trial.

The judge refused to make this ruling. The Supreme Court upheld the action of the trial judge.

On Moore's argument that the credibility of the Alibi witnesses for the defendants was not attacked, see *Lindenbaum vs. New York, New Haven & Hartford*, 197 Mass. page 314 at 323.

This case establishes the right of the jury to disbelieve the whole of the testimony of any witness or set of witnesses, saying at page 323, "The difficulty with the argument in support of the exception to the refusal of the judge to direct a verdict for the Union Freight Railroad Company is that although there was no evidence directly contradicting the account of the accident given by their witnesses, the jury had a right to disbelieve their testimony in toto."

"Perhaps no cause which really has two sides to it, can be determined without a serious belief in the party losing, and perhaps in his counsel, that the verdict was wrong and against the weight of the evidence. But disputes must be settled and finished and our law and constitution having given the ultimate decision upon the facts to the jury; to set aside their verdict unless in extraordinary cases where it is manifest that they have mistaken or abused their trust, will be to usurp a power which has been carefully and properly withheld from us."
