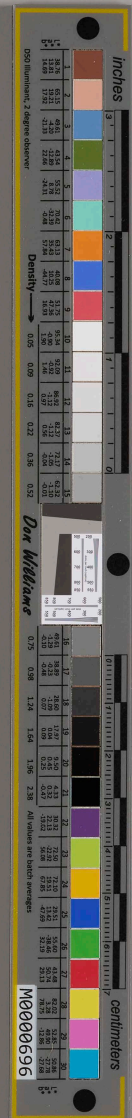

by which said wicked Arts the said Abigail Williams —
the four & twentieth Day of March — in the fourth
Year aforesaid and divers other Days & Times as well
before as after was & is hurt & tortured. Afflicted &
consumed & much wasted & tormented against the Peace
of our Sovereigns Lord & Lady the King & Queen
and against the Form of the Statute in that Case
made & Provided
