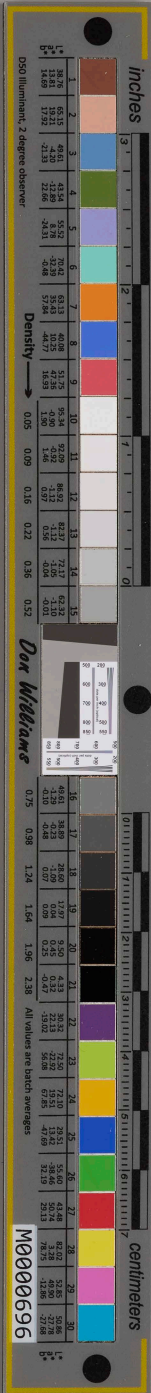


The Deposition of Sam. Paris aged about 39 years, & Nathanael 42
