Dependants had a Cow that could not kee alone, but since presently after she was taken up, the said Cow was well and did kisse so well, as if she had aied nothing: the the said Sarah good: ever since these Dependants have ^{been} out of their houses she hath ~~ever~~ ^{ever} behaved her self very crossly & maliciously, to them & now find you calling their Children Bile Names and hath threatened them often.
