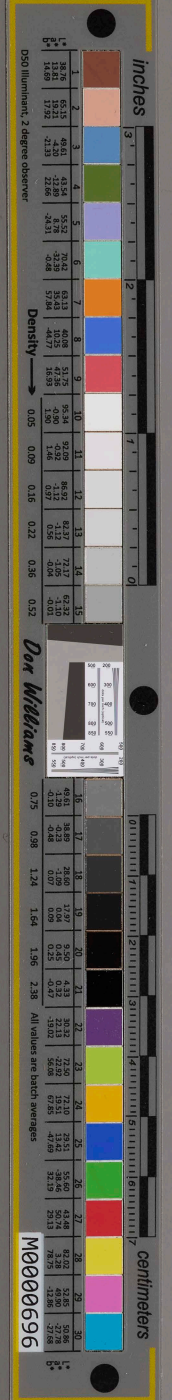


This may Certifie all whome this writing shall come before, that on the 15th of October 1692, Arthur Abbot sent for me Daniell Epps and Capt Thomas Wads Epp both of Ipswich, finding himselfe very weak and ill by reason of some sad distempers upon him, in order to the making his will and Coauding something that might be to the poine of the world Referring to the Evidence that he had given in to the Honored Court of Vice and tennors hold at Salom a little before, which was as followeth, Viz

J. Arthur Abbot having a great impulle upon me to declare into y^e Honored Court, as above sayd sitting in Salom, some things that I had formerly Discoursed with Godwife Specter of Salom about and upon in her House, being a former time after sent for by y^e worth Samuel Appleton Epp, And by him accus'd for taking a false oath therein. I doe humbly acknowledge my weaknes and reals sorrow for mentioning, stating the time, or any way insisting upon that, But being Extraordinarily Charged with falshood as to the things I had both seen and heard in her House, I did with more than ordinarie Expression ~~state~~ the truth thereof And doo as in the presence of God, before whose tribunall, both the accuser and the accused must appeare, Certinly affirme upon good Consideration and deep meditation, that to be true, which I had before declared to the Court, neither did I intend any of the fore great and solemn expressions at mayors Appletons, should any way be understood as to the time, but the things themselves, and this I desired to leave to the world, not knowing how it might please God to deal with me;

This was taken from Arthur Abbot at his earnest request, at the time above mentioned by ~~me~~ Daniell Epps J. J. I. Sabod this 9th of November 1692.

I also affirme y^t I did hear y^e said Arthur Abbot y^e day above mentioned when Capt Epps was present declare & affirme y^t what he had before said was y^e truth according as is above expressed, it being said to him by y^e like words after it was taken downe from his mouth, I am witness Tho. Wads. J. I.
