

In the above-named cases, on the third day of June, 1921, alphabetical lists of the names of jurors returned by the deputies of the Sheriff of the County of Norfolk, under order of the Court entered June 2nd, to serve in the trial of the above-named cases, were prepared by the Clerk and placed in the hands of the District Attorney and of counsel for the defense before the names of any of such jurors were drawn from the jury box. These lists were furnished without any demand having been made by the defendants or their counsel but were prepared as a matter of course in order to enable counsel to exercise their right of challenge.
