The Grand Jurors of the State of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations and for the Counties of Providence and Bristol, duly impanelled and sworn in said County of Providence, on the sixth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty upon their oaths present, That

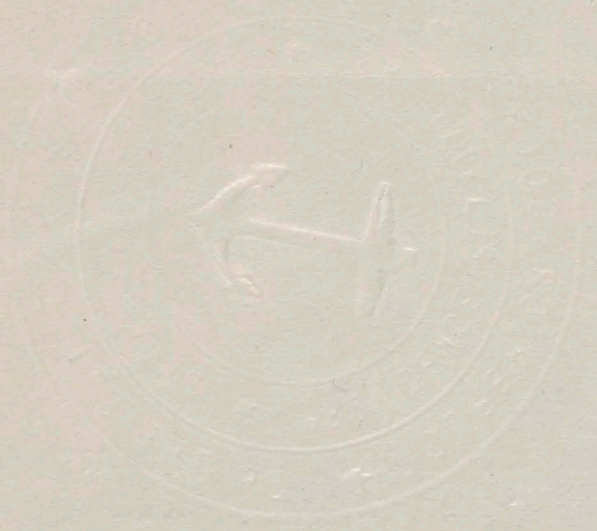
