We will observe Two Jima Day on Friday, February 19, 2014 in the following manner:


11:00 AM	Parade forms at Quincy Market/Faneuil Hall

1:30 PM	Collation in Hall of Flags

As you may know, they are both Boston Fire Fighters who are active with the Mass Fallen Heroes. Governor, this will be your last opportunity to participate in this event as Governor.
