**Whereas** It is appropriate that all residents recognize African immigrants for their many contributions to the cities and towns across our Commonwealth,

**Now, Therefore, I, Deval L. Patrick,** Governor of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, do hereby proclaim September 2012 to be,
