

The deposition of Anna Putnam the wife of Thomas Putnam who is
testified and saith that on the first day of June 1692 the Apperiti-
tion of Rebekah ^{my} did again fall upon me and almost choak me and she
told me that now she was come out of prison she had power to afflict
me and that now she would afflict me all this day long and would
kill me if she could for she told me she had killed Benjamin Holton
and John Pickett and ~~the~~ Rebekah Shepard: and she also told me that
she and her sister Cloye and Ed. Bishop wife of Salem village had
killed young Geo Putnam's child because young Geo Putnam had said
it was no wonder they were witches for their mother was so before them
and because they could not avenge themselves on him they ~~would~~ kill
his child: and immediately their did appeare to me: six children in win-
ding sheets which called me aunt: which did most grievously affright
me: and they told me that they were my sisters Bapers children of
Boston and that gooddy Murr and Nibbs Cary of Chalfston and an
old deaf woman at Boston had murdered them: and charged me
to goe and tell these things to the magistrates or else they would force
me to peace for their blood did cry for vengeance also their Appear-
ed to me my own sister Bayley and three of her children in winding
sheets and told me that gooddy Murr had murdered them
