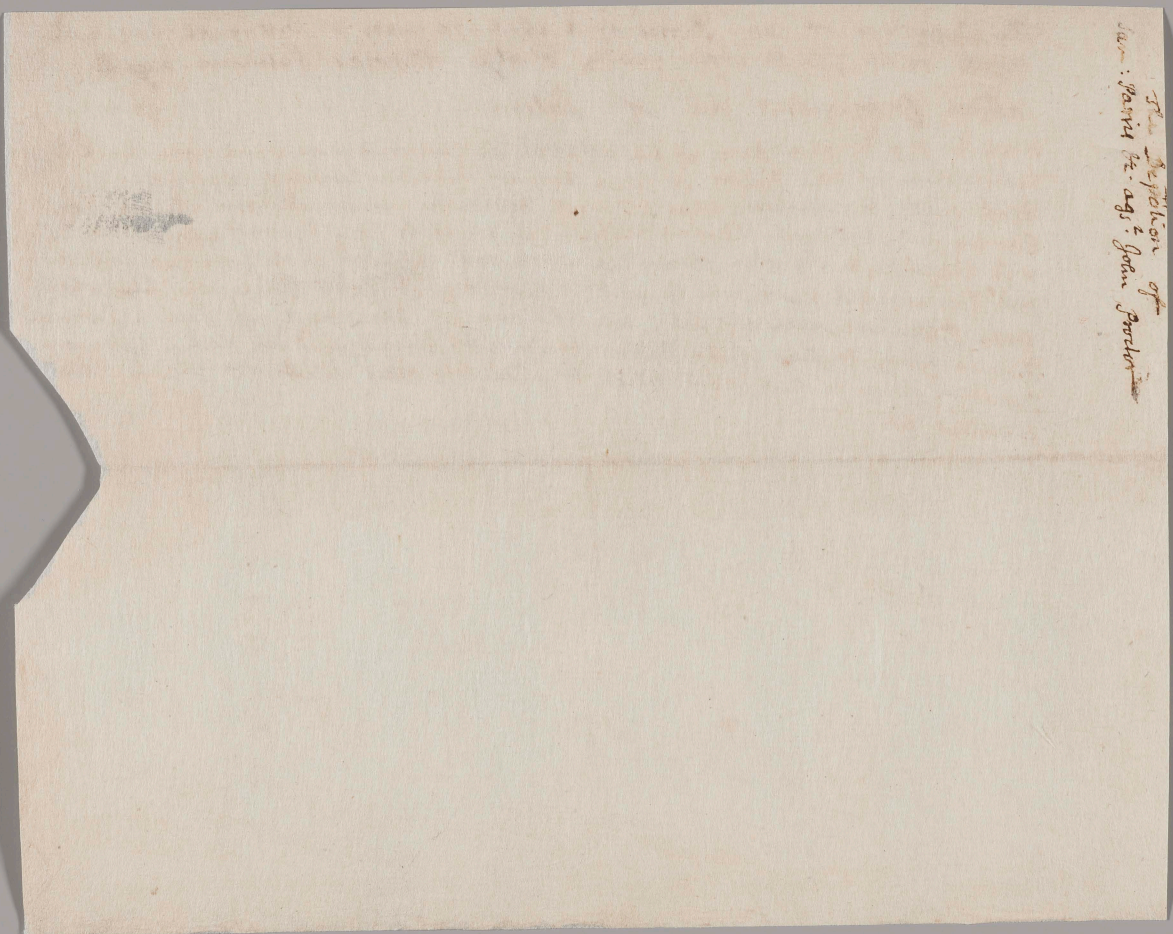


The Deposition of Sam: Parris aged about 39 years, & Nathanael Ingersoll
