Dear Governor Patrick:



The Lithuanian American community of Greater Boston will observe this 95th anniversary on Sunday, February 24th, 2013. One of the traditions at the State House, one of particular importance to the residents of the Commonwealth of Lithuanian heritage, has been the issuance and presentation of a proclamation by your Excellency in honor of the anniversary of Lithuania's Independence Day.

We wish to continue that tradition and respectfully request that a proclamation be issued declaring Saturday, February 16th, 2013 as LITHUANIAN INDEPENDENCE DAY!
