

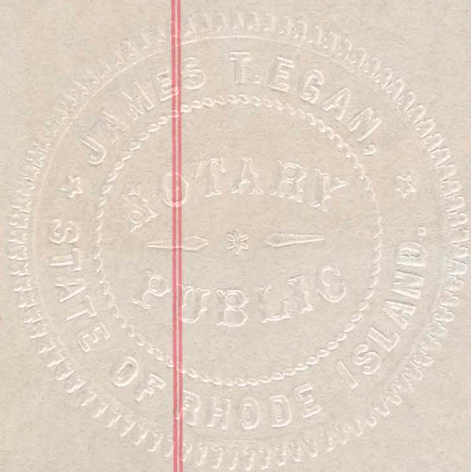
AFFIDAVIT OF EDWARD J. NOONS


I, Edward J. Noons, of the City and County of Providence
