and Lady William & Mary by the Grace of God of
England Scotland France and Ireland Defenders of
the faith &c. and divers other Days, and times, as
well before as after certain Detestable Artes
called witchcraft & sorceries: wickedly and felonious-
ly hath used Practise & exercised: at and
within the Towne Ship of Salem in the County
of Essex aforesaid. in upon and against Elizabeth
Hubbard of Salem aforesaid single woman: by such
said wicked arts the said Elizabeth Hubbard, the
said first Day of March in the fourth year
aforesaid: and at divers other days and times
as well before as after, was and is Tortured
afflicted: Pin'd, washed and tormented: as also for
undry other acts of witchcraft by the said Sarah
Good committed and done before and since
that time against the Person of our Sovereigne Lord
and Lady King & Queen of England, and against
the forme of the Statute in that Part made &
provid'd.
