

The Deposition of Abigail Williams and Ann Putnam who testified and said that we both going along with Goodman Abby and Sarah ~~staff~~ the 20th of May 1692 to the house of Constable Jno. Putnam ^{to see Mary Lewis} as we were in the way we ~~saw~~ both saw the Apparition of Gooddy Estick the very same woman that was sent whom the other day: and also the apparition of that woman that was with her the other day: and the Apparition of Gooddy Estick told us both that now she was afflicting of Misery Lewis because she would not cleave her as others did and we came to Misery Lewis who lay speechless and in a sad condition we saw these the Apparitions of Gooddy Estick and Jno. Willard and Mary Withersidge afflicting and choking Misery Lewis in a most dreadful manner: which did most grievously affright us: and immediately Gooddy Estick did fall upon us and tor-
-tor us also ready to choke us to death

Ann Putnam further testified y^e on 23 May 1692 being the last day of the examination of Mary Estick she did most grievously torment me during the time of her examination also on the same day I saw Mary Estick on her apparition most grievously torment and afflict Mary Walcott Misery Lewis Elizabeth Hubbard and Abigail Williams and I verily believe in my heart that Mary Estick is a most dreadful witch and that she hath very often afflicted me and the persons whose names by her oath of witness
