

# SACCO-VANZETTI

## TRIAL COST \$28,648

---

### Was Most Expensive Murder Case in Norfolk County

---

The Sacco-Vanzetti trial was the most expensive murder trial in the history of Norfolk county and cost \$28,648.76, according to the report of County Treasurer Fred C. Cobb yesterday.

The county officials had anticipated an expense of \$15,000, and appropriated that sum, but will have to make up the deficit of more than \$13,000.

The expense was largely incurred in selecting the jury which found Niccola Sacco and Bartolomeo Vanzetti guilty of the murder of Paymaster Parmenter and his guard, Patrolman Baradelli, at South Braintree. Counsel for the condemned men are still seeking a new trial.

The largest single item of expense is \$4200.40, expended in calling 675 talesmen. A number of these men found in halls and meeting places and on the streets, were pressed into service when all available panels were exhausted.

The expenses of the jury during seven weeks was \$2855.36, and of the various venires \$716.45, while summonsing and investigating prospective jurors cost \$581. The meals of jurors cost \$2703.50, while a one day's outing on a hot July day at Black Rock House, Nantasket, came to \$251.40.

The guarding of the court house following threatening letters to Judge Webster Thayer and Dist.-Atty. Katzmann cost \$1890. Expenses of \$18,406.55 grouped under the head of miscellaneous include \$2580.14 to Chief M. G. Stewart of the Bridgewater police for the use of his auto and other expenses; \$788.70 to Joseph Ross, an interpreter, and \$482.70 for witnesses fees. Capt. C. J. VamAmbrugh, pistol expert, received \$643.60.
