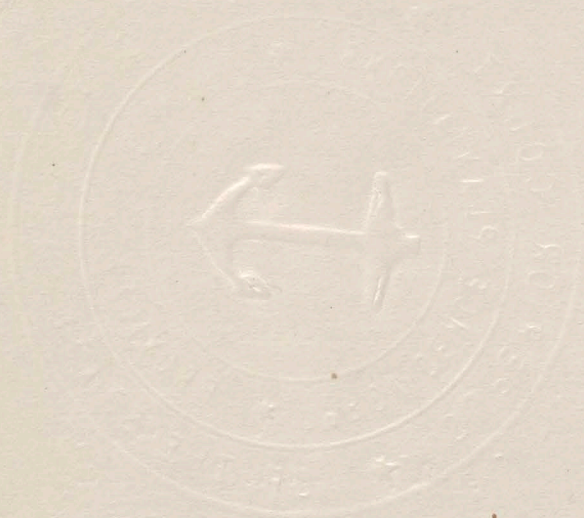

- 1919 Apr. 4 Doran J. Defts again severally arraigned each retracts and pleads nolo and Croft continued for sentence and for want of bail in the sum of 2000 is committed and Heaton sentence deferred.
- 1919 Aug. 14 Deft. Croft gives bail at jail.
- 1919 Nov. 3 Hahn J. Deft. Croft brought in on capias and sentenced to State Prison for 2 years and committed.
