

and Sorceries, wickedly, & feloniously, both Good
Practised, & executed, at and within the Township
of Salem in the County of Essex aforesaid in open
and against one Sarah Hibber wife of John Hibber
of Salem aforesaid Husband man, by whom said
wicked acts, the said Sarah Hibber, the said
second day of May in the fourth year aforesaid
and divers other dayes and times as well before
as after was and is tormented, afflicted, hindred,
contumeliously treated and demeaned, - and also for
 sundry other acts of witchcraft by said Sarah
Good committed and done before and since that
time against the Peace of our Sovereign Lord & Lady
the King & Queen their Crowne and Dignity and
against the forme of the Statute in that behalf made
and provided.
