
Dear Mr. Worthington:

We have carefully checked your draft of the Amended Bill
of Exceptions and find the following errors:

On Page 16, second to last paragraph at the end after
the words "by the Sacco-Vanzetti Defence Committee",
there should be added "or any one representing Sacco and
Vanzetti". I have checked this omission with Mr. Ranney
and Mr. Thompson and this has been confirmed by you in
my telephone conversation with you this afternoon. ✓

At the bottom of Page 24, there should be added the word
"property?" after the last word "private". At the top of
Page 25 before the first word "property", there should be
inserted "Has our religion come to be private?". On Page
30, last line, the word "filed" should be "files". On
Page 31, the last word in the second last paragraph should
be "files" instead of "filed".
